THEORY AND PRACTICE OF COMBATING TERRORISM

30 hours / 1 ECTS

- in combating it under modern conditions;
- theoretical principles and elements of modern counterterrorism strategies. Fundamentals of terrorogenesis;
- innovative and proactive management in the field of security and defense. Strategic communications and risk-oriented technologies in counterterrorism activities;
- management of counterterrorism activities. Structure and tasks of the state system for combating terrorism in Ukraine;
- practice of counterterrorism with the use of modern information space capabilities. Information logistics as the basis of anti-terrorist security;
- rules of anti-terrorist security. Anti-terrorist training for the population.

NEGOTIATING IN EXTREME CONDITIONS

54 hours / 1 ECTS

- assessment and analysis of extreme situations: ability to analyze counterterrorism strategies, create psychological profiles of terrorists, and predict their behavior;
- psychological readiness for negotiations: ability to figure out mental states, deal with stress and fear, and act effectively under psychological pressure;
- the use of psychological methods in negotiations: command of influential techniques, persuasion, and de-escalation in critical situations;
- tactical behavior in interpersonal interaction: the ability to adapt to challenging situations, to choose effective negotiation strategies according to the type of conflict.

SANCTIONS – A STATE SECURITY POLICY TOOL

30 hours / **1** ECTS

- classification of sanction types (economic, financial, personal, sectoral, etc.);
- analysis of Ukrainian legislation on sanctions, as well as the international legal framework (UN, EU, US, G7);
- procedural aspects of initiating, imposing, implementing, and monitoring sanctions;
- identifying sanctions evasion schemes and participating in measures to prevent them;
- analytical support for sanctions targets and identification of risks in the economic, financial, and security spheres.

PSYCHOLOGY OF TERRORISM AND COUNTER-TERRORISM STRATEGIES

40 hours / **1,4** ECTS

- comprehension of psychological and social mechanisms of radicalization and terrorism. Case studies of radicalization in Ukraine and worldwide;
- psychology of terrorist organizations and groups;
- impact of terrorism on society;
- counter-terrorism methods;
- cyberterrorism and information warfare;
- international experience in combating terrorism. NATO and EU strategies for counterterrorism;
- working out own anti-terrorism strategies and programs.

DIGITAL DETECTIVE

45 hours / **1,5** ECTS

- conduct basic analysis of digital fingerprints;
- detect and record digital evidence with Kali Linux tools;
- be aware of the procedures for collecting and documenting digital evidence;
- be able to collect digital evidence from cell phones, computers, and laptops;
- be aware of the main tasks of computer-technical expertise;
- search for information about individuals and legal entities on the Internet;
- prepare reports based on data obtained from digital devices.

CRITICAL INFRASTRUCTURE PROTECTION

30 hours / **1** ECTS

- classification of critical infrastructure objects and assessment of their importance in national security;
- identifying threats and assessing the vulnerabilities of critical infrastructure objects;
- planning countermeasures against sabotage, terrorist acts, and cyberattacks;
- counter-sabotage protection of state critical infrastructure objects in wartime and under martial law.

STRENGTHENING INTEGRITY IN THE SECURITY AND DEFENSE SECTOR WITHIN THE FRAMEWORK OF UKRAINE'S EUROPEAN AND ATLANTIC INTEGRATION

30 hours / 1 ECTS /

- identification of main forms of corruption in Ukraine's security and defense sector;
- analysis of Ukraine's anti-corruption legislation and the experiences of EU and NATO member states in promoting integrity;
- assessment of the effective measures to prevent corruption;
- use of transparency, accountability, and interest conflict management mechanisms.

PERSONNEL SAFETY IN THE SECURITY AND DEFENSE SECTOR OF UKRAINE

30 hours / 1 ECTS

- personal security management;
- measures and special means for the personal safety of security and defense sector personnel;
- mental processes, states, and psychological reactions of a person in extreme conditions;
- verbal and nonverbal means of communication in extreme conditions.

OPERATIONAL PSYCHOLOGY

30 hours / 1 ECTS

- technologies for operational personality analysis;
- identification of psychological characteristics of an individual's behavior through profiling;
- verbal and nonverbal signs of concealing information;
- ways of predicting characteristics of interpersonal interactions between individuals with different personality types.

STRESS MANAGEMENT IN WARTIME

30 hours / 1 ECTS

- mental states under extreme conditions;
- providing first psychological aid in the case of acute psycho-emotional states;
- psychological support for military personnel and their families;
- developing anti-stress skills.

STATE SECRETS PROTECTION

30 hours / **1** ECTS

- implementation of organizational and legal measures to protect state secrets;
- coordination of agency's departments on matters related to the protection of state secrets;
- granting clearance and access to state secrets to an agency staff;
- methods to organize the work of a classified agency;
- drafting and processing confidential documents;
- developing the system for protecting state secrets in Ukraine using the experience of NATO in dealing with classified information.

METHODS TO ORGANIZE INFORMATION AND ANALYTICAL ACTIVITIES

60 hours / **2** ECTS

- use of advanced methods of data analysis, gathering, and processing to conduct research in the field of national security;
- principles of open source intelligence (OSINT) search. Basic definitions of OSINT. Basic OSINT methodology;
- the Internet search for information on individuals and legal entities;
- use of artificial intelligence technology for data analysis;
- finding objects in digital space using available images; Excel information processing capabilities;
- Berkeley Protocol in law enforcement;
- creating reports based on data gathered from digital devices.

STRATEGIC COMMUNICATION IN THE ARAB WORLD

30 hours / **1** ECTS

- understanding the main features of the Arab mentality and way of thinking, the nature of their reactions to the Russian-Ukrainian war, and creating effective models for successful interaction with the region in the interests of Ukraine;
- cultural and religious factors in the Arab world;
- Arabic system of values;
- geopolitical trends in the Arab world;
- Ukraine's relations with the Arab world: challenges, opportunities, and prospects.

ANTI-CRISIS NEGOTIATIONS: STRATEGY AND TACTICS IN CONFLICT SITUATIONS

40 hours / **1,4** ECTS

- understanding the behavior and motivation of terrorists;
- the ability to adapt negotiation strategy to a specific type of threat and situation;
- use of psychological influence techniques, and methods of countering manipulation as well as of emotional self-regulation under pressure;
- communicative flexibility and interaction in operational groups. Ability to tailor communication to the context and participants' roles;
- information management in crisis situations, ability to develop effective information campaigns, prevent data leaks and counter misinformation;
- development of tactical response plans, scenarios and algorithms for actions in crisis negotiations.

RUSSIAN SLANG IN THE FIELD OF SECURITY AND DEFENSE (basic course)

30 hours / 1 ECTS

- indicators of professional readiness among security and defense forces of the Russian Federation. The role of linguistic and slang markers of professional readiness among intelligence officers, saboteurs, etc;
- Russian military slang: nature, meaning, and classification;
- the peculiarities and distinctive features of the jargon used by the staff of the Federal Security Service and the Main Directorate of the General Staff of the Armed Forces of the Russian Federation;
- jargon used by Russian army personnel; the ability to adapt negotiation strategy to a specific type of threat and situation;
- slang used by Cossack groups, private military companies, and criminal groups involved in the war against Ukraine;
- classification of Russian military slang by object names;
- difficulties in interpreting Russian military slang.
